Curriculum

i-Ready is an online platform designed to assess and enhance students' reading and mathematics skills. At the beginning of summer, students will take the i-Ready Diagnostic assessment to identify their current performance levels, enabling us to tailor support to their specific needs. At the end of summer, a follow-up assessment will measure their growth over the period. Based on diagnostic results, i-Ready creates personalized learning paths with lessons suited to each student's level, and teachers can assign additional lessons to address various learning needs. Since i-Ready is utilized in Charlotte-Mecklenburg Schools (CMS), students are already familiar with the platform, ensuring continuity in their learning experience from school to summer.
